Kathy's Recipes



Spring is here! Time to roundup those Keets for some natural egg dying! These springtime eggs will be beautiful and delicious!

You will need some red onion skins, vinegar, eggs and a large pot. Wash the eggs well in vinegar mixed with water.

Bring the water to a boil then add the onion skins and simmer for 20 minutes. Remove the eggs and dry on paper towels. For shiny eggs rub with pork grease. You can have any color you want. Here are a few colors to try.

**for green eggs use spinach leaves*

**for blue eggs use red cabbage or blueberries*

**for yellow eggs use carrots or turmeric*

**for dark pink use beets*

And those red onion skins? They will turn the eggs red.

Marisela & Luis' Drink of the Month

Classic Bourbon Mint Julep

Ingredients

- 4 to 5 mint sprigs, leaves only
- 2 sugar cubes, or 1/2 ounce simple syrup
- 2 1/2 ounces bourbon whiskey
- Mint sprig, for garnish

Instructions

Gather the ingredients. Place the mint leaves and sugar or simple syrup into a julep cup, Collins glass, or double old-fashioned glass. Muddle well to dissolve the sugar and release the oil and aroma of the mint. Add the bourbon. Fill the glass with crushed ice and stir well until the glass becomes frosty. Garnish with a mint sprig. Serve with a straw and enjoy.

Tips

Gently muddle your mint. The intention is to release the essential oils, not tear the leaves to bits.

Once you build the drink, take the time to stir it gently until the glass gets frosty. This should take at least 30 seconds, but the longer you do it, the better.

Pour your favorite bourbon. It's best to choose one of the higher-end brands for the simple fact that bourbon is the Julep's only liquid. Though it is sweetened and flavored, the whiskey is primarily what you will taste.

Before garnishing with the mint sprig, gently slap it with your hands to release the aromatic oils of the mint.
