

The Painkiller

As the days begin to heat up, it's time for an ol' favorite -

Ingredients:

2 ounces Pusser's rum

4 ounces pineapple juice

1 ounce orange juice, freshly squeezed

1 ounce cream of coconut

Garnish: nutmeg, freshly grated

Garnish: pineapple wedge



Directions:

Add the rum, pineapple juice, orange juice and cream of coconut to a shaker with cubed ice and shake briefly to combine.

Strain into hurricane glass or snifter over crushed ice.

Garnish with freshly grated nutmeg and a pineapple wedge.

Serve with a straw.
