Classic Green "Luck of the Irish" Drink

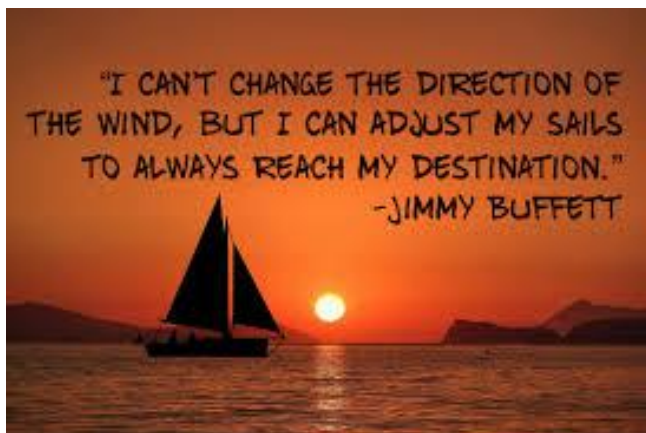
Ingredients:
