

Kathy's Recipes

Creamy Coconut Lime Salmon

This fish tastes like a Tropical Vacation! The sauce is almost too good! Trust us, you are going to love this!

Ingredients

2 tbsp coconut oil divided

4 (6 oz) skinless salmon fillets, patted dry

1tsp kosher salt divided

1/2 small onion, minced

2 cloves garlic, minced

1 1/2 piece ginger, grated

1 13.66oz can Thai Kitchen coconut milk

1 tbsp fresh lime juice plus lime wedges for serving chopped fresh basil

1 Fresno chili seeded and chopped.



- 1. In a large cast iron skillet heat 1 tablespoon oil . Season the salmon with 1/2 teaspoon salt. When oil is hot but not smoking, add salmon skin side up. Let sit undisturbed until golden and salmon releases from the pan.(4minutes). Use a thin spatula to flip fish.
- 2. Reduce heat to medium add remaining oil to the skillet, Cook until softened. Add garlic and ginger, stir a minute.. Stir in coconut milk and simmer. Cook until done. Garnish with chili and lime wedges.
