




Hot Toddy *Mocktail* Recipe

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 black tea bag
- 4 tbsp honey
- 4 tsp lemon juice freshly squeezed
- 2 tsp cinnamon ground
- 1 tsp star anise
- 1 tsp nutmeg ground
- 2 lemon wedges
- 2 cinnamon sticks



INSTRUCTIONS:

Brew 16 ounces of water in small pot until boiling
Drop black tea bag for 3-5 minutes.
Once brewed, remove the tea bag and add the honey, lemon juice, ground cinnamon, star anise and ground nutmeg.
Stir quickly with a spoon and pour into 2 cups
Garnish with a wedge of lemon and a cinnamon stick.
Serve immediately.
