Kathy's Recipes

Coconut Cream Pie

From Pepe's Cafe Key West

Filling

- 6 egg yolks
- 2 tsp coconut extract
- 1 cup sugar
- 6 heaping tbs cornstarch
- 6 cups Half & Half
- 2 cups flaked and sweetened coconut

Crust

- 2 prepared graham cracker crusts



Mix together the eggs and the coconut extract and set aside

In heavy saucepan combine sugar, cornstarch and Half & Half. Bring to a boil stirring constantly.

When mixture is bubbling add one cup to the eggs to warm the egg mixture.

Return all the egg mixture to the Half & Half and continue cooking.

Stir with a

whisk constantly until well combined and mixture is bubbling again.

Remove from heat and stir in coconut.

Cool to room temperature and turn into

2 graham cracker pie crusts. Chill. Serve with whipped cream.

Makes 2 pies, 12 servings, 6 per pie
