We were at Rio Guadalupe Resort, which is downstream from Canyon Lake. Our cabins were on the river but if you have ever been to this resort, you know those cabins are about 100 feet from the river. I woke up about 4:30 AM to pouring rain. I was a little nervous because I am aware of the walls of water that have come down the Guadalupe River in my lifetime. One of them was on the Guadalupe River at River Road, the road Rio Guadalupe Resort is on. I told myself I was being silly by having anxiety and finally went back to sleep. Little did I know that a wall of water was happening upriver from Canyon Lake. When I got up on July 4th, I got several texts from friends asking if we were OK. The rest of the family were getting texts too. We were a little confused by all the concern. We hadn't turned on the TV, so we had no idea what had happened in Kerr County. Finally, around noon we became aware of the heartbreaking situation. We monitored the weather and possible flooding in our area from then on while playing cards at the pavilion by the pool. When given rain you make rainbows.
