Welcome to WILDLIFE RESCUE & REHABILITATION

SAPHC is excited to welcome a new charity to support.

Founded in 1977 by great-hearted benefactor, Lynn Cuny, WILDLIFE RESCUE & REHABILITATION (WRR) is a local organization dedicated to saving injured, sick, or orphaned wild animals. Their goal is to get them healthy and ready to fend for themselves and to ultimately release them back into the wild.


Sadly, in some circumstances wildlife simply can't be released (think: abandoned pet Pot Belly Pigs, parrots, monkeys, or animals and birds with permanent disabling injuries, including bears, big cats, farm animals, and non-native species). For these wild critters, with the generous help of Lynn Cuny and many friends, donors and volunteers, WRR has grown into a 212 acre sanctuary located just north of Kendalia, TX which includes a fullystaffed rehab hospital and veterinary clinic.

They also have an in-town Wildlife Complex which, to quote their website, "serves as a dropoff point for injured and orphaned wildlife, a temporary rehabilitation center for certain species of orphaned mammals and birds, and an education center."

The Parrot Heads look forward to supporting WRR primarily through funds raised at our Happy Hours but there also opportunities to volunteer your time as well. Take it from Doc & Susan Blanchard, it's a very rewarding experience.


