Kathy's Recipes

GRILLED CORN SALAD

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 ears fresh corn
- 4 tbs Olive oil
- 1 small red bell pepper finely chopped
- 1 small zucchini quartered and sliced 1/4 inch thick
- 1 large shallot finely chopped
- 1 large clove garlic, grated
- 1/2 cup thinly sliced fresh basil
- 3 tbs Balsamic Vinegar
- 3/4 tsp Kosher salt
- 1/2 tsp black pepper



DIRECTIONS:

Prepare grill and corn.

Preheat grill or grill pan to medium (400 - 450 degrees)

Coat with 1 tablespoon of the olive Oil

Grill the corn

Place corn on oiled grates uncovered and turning occasionally -
10 minutes on grill

Cut corn off the cob.

Place in a large bowl. Cool for 5 minutes.

Toss salad ingredients together and enjoy
