Ingredients

- 1 cup boiling water
- 1 (3 ounce) package lime-flavored gelatin mix
- ½ cup tequila
- 1/3 cup triple sec
- ½ cup water
- 7 limes

Directions

- Cut limes in half and carve out lime pulp save the rind "shells"
