## Marisela's and Luis' Drink of the Month

## Puerto Rican Coquito

#### Ingredients:

1 can <u>full fat coconut milk (13 oz)</u>

1 can <u>cream of coconut (15 oz)</u>

1 can <u>sweetened condensed</u>

<u>milk</u> 14 oz

1 can <u>evaporated milk</u> 12 oz

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

 $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon ground nutmeg

¼ teaspoon ground cloves optional

1 teaspoon vanilla extract



<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> cup light or dark rum or more or less, to your taste.

#### Instructions:

In a blender, add evaporated milk, cream of coconut, coconut milk, sweetened condensed milk, rum, vanilla extract and spices. Blend on high until mixture is well combined, 1-2 minutes.

Pour coquito mixture into glass bottles, cover. Transfer to refrigerator. Chill for 1-2 hours, or until cold.

To serve, stir or shake bottle well to combine. Pour coquito into small serving glasses. Garnish with ground cinnamon and cinnamon sticks, if desired.
