Marisela's and Luis' Drink of the Month

Sparkling Rosé Margarita

Ingredients:

10 ounces strawberry-basil-infused blanco tequila*

5 ounces lime juice, freshly squeezed

4 ounces agave syrup

1 (750 mL) bottle sparkling rosé

Garnish: 1 cup strawberries, sliced

Garnish: lime wheels

Garnish: rose salt**



In a punch bowl, combine the tequila, lime juice and agave syrup.

Add cubed ice, and stir with a ladle to mix.

Top with the sparkling rosé.

Garnish punch with 1 cup sliced strawberries and lime wheels from 2 limes.

Rim punch glasses with rose salt before serving (optional).

***Strawberry-basil-infused blanco tequila:** In a glass jar, combine 1/2 cup sliced strawberries and 1/2 cup fresh basil leaves with 1 750 milliliter bottle of blanco tequila. Seal the jar tightly and let sit, unrefrigerated, for 3 to 5 days. Shake daily. Strain out the solids, and rebottle the infused tequila.

****Rose salt:** Add 1/4 cup sea salt and 1 tablespoon dried rose buds to a mortar and pestle, and gently grind. Place on a small plate to use for rimming the glasses.
