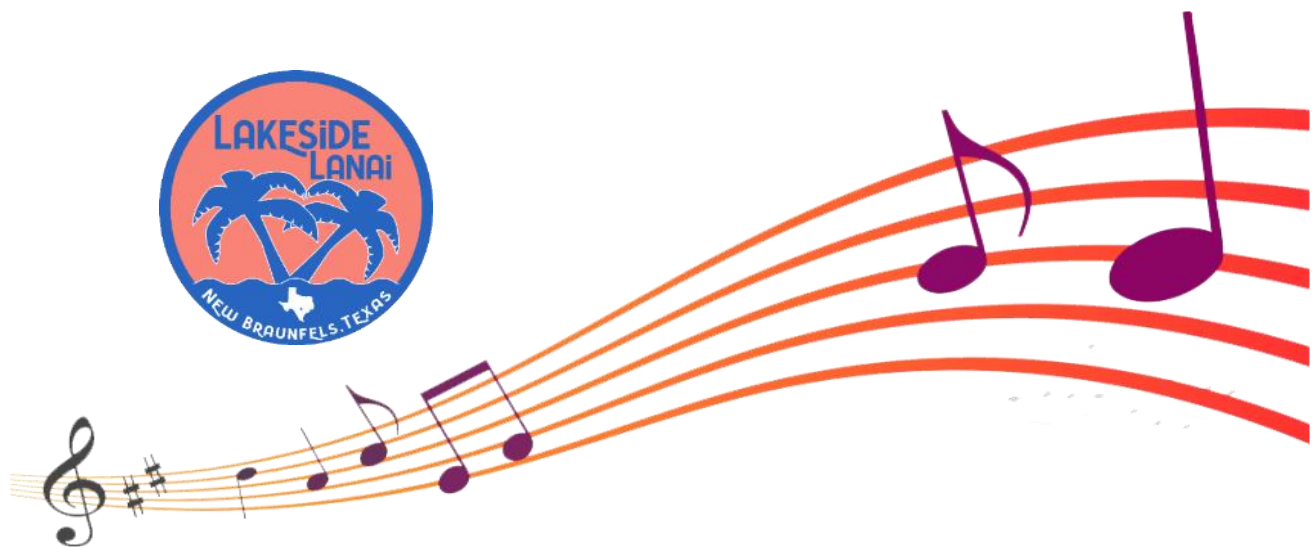

Ingredients:

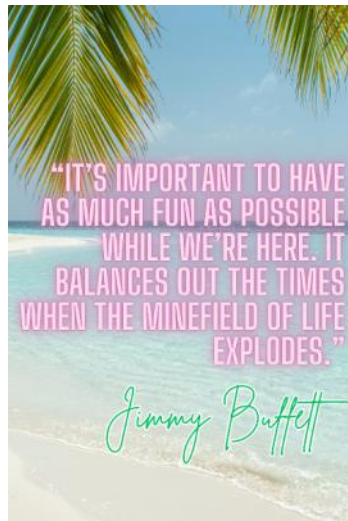
2 oz Blanco Tequila
