- Ice

Directions:

Fill ice reservoir with ice. Pour ingredients in glass jar. Concoct until smooth. Pour into your favorite glass and enjoy. Makes 2-3 drinks.





Kathy's Recipes

Tailgate Totchos

Yes Parrotheads, it's Spring and that means Concerts. And that means Tailgating! Here's a recipe bound to please!

Ingredients:

- 1 16oz package frozen potatoes
- 4 fresh tomatillos, husks removed, halved
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- 1 teaspoon ancho chile powder
- 2 cups charred corn kernels (3 ears)
- 2 jalapenos, thinly sliced
- 18 oz. white cheese dip, warmed

2 ripe avocados halved 1/2 cup fresh lime juice 2 teaspoons salt, divided 3 cups shredded chicken 1/3 cups diced tomatoes cilantro to taste



- 1. Cook potato tots according to package directions
- 2. Process avocados, tomatillos, cilantro, lime juice, cumin, and 1 teaspoon salt in a blender till smooth.
- 3. Stir together ancho chile powder and remaining salt in a small bowl. Sprinkle mixture over hot tater tots. Top tots with shredded chicken and chopped bacon. Drizzle with warm cheese dip and avocado mixture. Top with corn, tomato, and jalapeno slices. Serve immediately.
