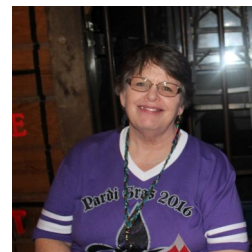

Tailgate Totchos

Yes Parrotheads, it's Spring and that means Concerts. And that means Tailgating! Here's a recipe bound to please!

Ingredients:

| 1 16oz package frozen potatoes | 2 ripe avocados halved |
| 4 fresh tomatillos, husks removed, halved | 1/2 cup fresh lime juice |
| 1 teaspoon cumin | 2 teaspoons salt, divided |
| 1 teaspoon ancho chile powder | 3 cups shredded chicken |
| 2 cups charred corn kernels (3 ears) | 1/3 cups diced tomatoes |
| 2 jalapenos, thinly sliced | cilantro to taste |
| 1 8 oz. white cheese dip, warmed | |



1. Cook potato tots according to package directions
2. Process avocados, tomatillos, cilantro, lime juice, cumin, and 1 teaspoon salt in a blender till smooth.
3. Stir together ancho chile powder and remaining salt in a small bowl. Sprinkle mixture over hot tater tots. Top tots with shredded chicken and chopped bacon. Drizzle with warm cheese dip and avocado mixture. Top with corn, tomato, and jalapeno slices. Serve immediately.
