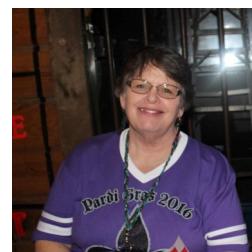

Jimmy Parrish at Isla Bella

Jimmy Parrish will be at Isla Bella in Floresville on Saturday, March 11 for a great house concert! It's been 4 years since Jimmy was in the San Antonio area and we're excited he's coming back. You can let Fred Guerrero know that you're attending if you haven't yet signed up. Cost is \$20 per person and bring your own chair, drinks and a side dish. Here is a bit about Jimmy....

JIMMY PARRISH AND SHRIMPBOAT ROCK

When I met Jimmy Parrish and he referred to his music as "Shrimpboat Rock," it made perfect sense to me. Jimmy is tall and lean and looks as if he'd be right at home on any kind of boat. A long time resident of Jacksonville, Florida, he has been performing since the early 1980s.

Jimmy's roots were Southern rock (hasn't that genre influenced so many Trop Rock performers?) and he describes himself as a "southern rock junkie." Lynard Skynard helped shaped his musical taste, but he has been part of the Trop Rock scene from the ground up. His Ocean Waves Band has performed Trop Rock exclusively since 2000.

Jimmy has three recordings under his belt and put out his first solo album in 2003. The latest CD is entitled "Acts of Piracy." He has partnered with Ocean Waves Sunglasses and was given permission to use their name and logo. You might catch Jimmy at a Parrothead event in any part of the nation, but his music is heard mostly in the Southeast. Jimmy Parrish and his "Americanized Island Music" is definitely on my personal list of "must listen!"

Kathy's Recipes

Chocolate Covered February/ Texas Sheet Cake with Fudge Icing

Texas Parrotheads claimed the sheet cake as their own perhaps because of the pecans, which many can gather from their own backyards.

The shape of the cake is distinctive, but the icing really takes the cake here! This rich chocolate-ly cake is loved by all!

Ingredients:

1 1/2 cups Dr Pepper	1/2 teaspoon table salt
1 cup vegetable or canola oil	1/2 cup buttermilk
1/2 cup unsweetened coca	
2 cups all purpose flour	2 teaspoons vanilla extract
1 cup granulated sugar	2 large eggs lightly beaten
1 cup firmly packed brown sugar	Cooking spray
1 1/2 teaspoons baking soda	1 1/4 cups chopped toasted pecans

1 Preheat oven to 350. Bring first 3 ingredients to a boil in a medium saucepan over medium-high heat, stirring often. Remove from heat.

2 Whisk together flour and next 4 ingredients in a large bowl. Add soft drink mixture, whisk till blended. Wisk in buttermilk eggs and vanilla. Pour batter into a lightly greased 17 1/2 x 12 1/2 inch sheet pan.

3 Bake at 350 for 18 to 22 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean.

Prepare fudge icing and pour over warm cake. Sprinkle with pecans. Cool Completely in the pan.

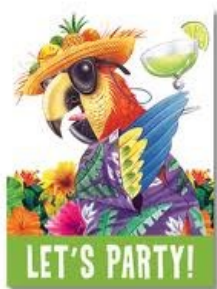
Icing:

1/2 cup butter	3 tablespoons Dr. Pepper
1/2 (4oz) unsweetened chocolate baking bar, chopped	4 cups powdered sugar
3 tablespoons milk	1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Cook butter and chocolate in a medium saucepan over medium-low heat whisking constantly. Wisk in vanilla. Use immediately.
