And, Buffett/ Kimbrough/McAnally on "A Lot to Drink About."



Kathy's Recipes

The BEST Fried Eggplant Sandwich

Yes Parrotheads, this is the BEST. As one who will eat anything eggplant, I read this recipe and made it the next day. YUMMY!

- 2 smallish purple egaplants (1/1/2 lbs)
- 2 tbls Kosher salt
- 1 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 4 lg eggs
- 2 tbls grated parmesan cheese4 hero rolls
- 2 to 3 tbls mayonnaíse8 oz fresh mozzarella cut into thin slices
- 8 oz slíced cooked roast beef
- 1 cup hot cherry peppers, or to taste, sliced
- 1. Line a cookie sheet with paper towels. Trim stem end from eggplants, then peel and discard skin. Slice the eggplants LENGTHWISE into 3/16 inch thick slabs. Arrange eggplant in a single layer on the baking sheet. Sprinkle both sides of the slices with salt. Let stand 10-15 minutes. Pat dry with paper towels, remove some of the salt, and stack on a plate.
- 2. Discard the wet paper towels and replace with more. In a large deep skillet heat the oil over medium heat. Fry the eggplant slabs until just tender 30 to 40 seconds per side. Drain on paper towels. Turn off burner.
- 3. In a large bowl, whisk together eggs and parm cheese. Return skillet to the stove over medium-high heat until oil is hot again.
- 4. Díp drained eggplant in egg batter, then fry in oil until puffed, lightly golden and cooked through, 2 to 4 minutes. Drain again.
- 5. Assemble sandwiches. Cut the rolls open, then spread each one with mayo. Layer the slices of eggplant onto the bread in equal portions, and top with equal portions of mozzarella and roast


