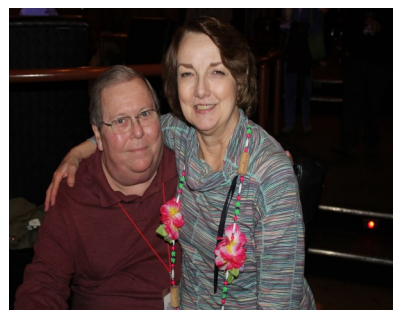
February Happy Hour

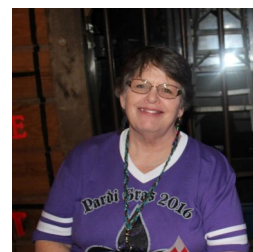

Kathy's Recipes

GUINNESS and IRISH CHEDDAR MACARONI & CHEESE

Creamy, check. Cheesy, check. Garlicky, check. Here's a grownup version of a Parrot Head favorite. Classic, Check!

Ingredients:

1 pound elbow macaroni	1/2 teaspoon salt
2 tablespoons butter	1/4 teaspoon black pepper
2 tablespoons flour	1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
2/3 cup Guinness	2 oz. cream cheese, cut in pieces
1 1/2 cups 2% milk	3 1/2 cups grated Irish Cheddar
1/2 cup half & half	

Topping:

1 tablespoon butter	salt/ pepper to taste
2 teaspoons finely minced garlic	2 teaspoons minced parsley
1/2 cup panko crumbs

Instructions for topping: In a medium skillet over medium heat, melt butter. Add garlic and breadcrumbs and cook, stirring frequently until breadcrumbs are toasted. Remove from heat, add salt, pepper and parsley. Set aside.

Macaroni and Cheese: Boil elbow macaroni in well salted water and cook until al dente. Before draining the pasta, reserve a cup of the pasta water and set aside. (You can add a little bit of this water later if the pasta thickens too much.) While the pasta is cooking, make the cream sauce.

In a large saucepan over medium heat, melt butter and sprinkle in flour. Whisk together for a minute. While whisking, pour in Guinness, milk, half & half, salt, pepper and mustard. Bring to a simmer and cook, whisking until it thickens slightly (several minutes). Add cream cheese and 2 1/2 cups grated cheddar and whisk until smooth. Add drained pasta and stir to combine. Add remaining 1 cup cheese and stir until melted. Top with breadcrumbs. Transfer to a serving bowl and serve immediately. Enjoy!
